No glass containers allowed in pool area
No smoking in pool area
No running or horseplay in pool area

## Each homeowner/resident choosing to use our community pool agrees to abide by the following pool rules:

- 1. Swimmers must shower before entering the pool.
- 2. Pets are not allowed in the pool area
- 3. Unattended solo bathing is not recommended.
- 4. Children under the age of 14 shall not use the pool without an adult (21 yrs. or older) in attendance.
- 5. No running or roughhouse play is allowed around the pool.
- 6. No diving.
- 7. No spitting or spouting of water.
- 8. No cutoffs or exposed diapers permitted in the pool.
- 9. No food, drink or glass containers in or around the pool.
- 10. Persons with open cuts or blisters are excluded from the pool.
- 11. No swimming is allowed during heavy rain or when thunder or lightning can can be seen or heard.

In addition to the above-posted rules, the HOA includes the following guidelines that all homeowners/residents using the pool are expected to observe:

- 1. The pool facility is an amenity for use by Waterford Landing Homeowner Association members only, who are current on all HOA dues. Persons who are not residents of the community may not use the pool unless they are the guests of a Waterford Landing homeowner.
- 2. The pool hours are from 8:00 am until 9:00 pm. Please be respectful of our neighbors living near the pool.
- 3. It is requested that persons replace chairs and tables before leaving the pool area and close all pool umbrellas.
- 4. Inappropriate behavior, foul language or disregard for the safety of others will not be tolerated and could result in suspension of pool privileges.
- 5. Smoking or use of alcoholic beverages is not permitted anywhere near the pool area at any time.

Also, be aware that you use the pool at your own risk. A lifeguard will not be posted and the homeowners association and community accept no responsibility for the safety of anyone using the pool.
